

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (B5289 HIGH HILL, KESWICK) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME AND PROHIBITION OF LOADING/UNLOADING, AT ANY TIME) AND (U7003 THIRLMERE) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES (EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) AND NO RIGHT- TURN) AND (A591 NO U-TURN) ORDER 2022

The County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (4) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 August 2022 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (B5289 High Hill, Keswick) (No Waiting At Any time) and (Thirlmere) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles (Except for Access) and No Right Turn) and (A591 No U-Turn) Order 2022
2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time, on any day, or to allow goods to be loaded or unloaded (including Blue Badge Holders), along both sides of the B5289 High Hill Keswick, from its junction with the A66, extending in an easterly direction for approx. 600m.
3. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in the said Article if the vehicle is: -
 - (a) a vehicle directly used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) undertaking any building operation, demolition or excavation;
 - (ii) the collection of waste by the council or local authority;
 - (iii) the cleansing of roads by the council or local authority;
 - (iv) removing an obstruction to traffic;
 - (v) undertaking works in relation to a road, a traffic sign or road lighting; or
 - (v) undertaking works in relation to a sewer or water main or in relation to the supply of gas, electricity, water or communications services.
 - (b) a vehicle being used in the service of a council or local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties and is displaying a valid dispensation issued by the council or local authority; or

- (c) a vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953; or
 - (d) an armoured vehicle that is being used for the supply/collection of monies to/from a bank or building society; or
 - (e) a vehicle used in connection with the removal of a coffin containing the remains of a deceased person; or
 - (f) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, police, ambulance or first responder purposes; or
 - (g) a vehicle displaying a valid dispensation and/or certificate of exemption issued by the Council or Local Authority.
4. Save as provided in Article 5, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the U7003 at Thirlmere, from a point approximately 550m south-west of its junction with the A591 at Bridge End Farm, to a point approximately 63m east of its junction with "Raven Cragg" car park southern fork.
5. Nothing in Article 4 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to in the said Article if the vehicle is: -
- (a) a vehicle directly used in connection with any of the following operations, namely: -
 - (i) undertaking any building operation, demolition or excavation
 - (ii) the collection of waste by the council or local authority;
 - (iii) the cleansing of roads by the council or local authority;
 - (iv) removing an obstruction to traffic;
 - (v) undertaking works in relation to a road, a traffic sign or road lighting; or
 - (vi) undertaking works in relation to a sewer or water main or in relation to the supply of gas, electricity, water or communications services; or
 - (b) a vehicle being used in the service of a council or local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties; or
 - (c) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, police, ambulance or first responder purposes; or

- (d) a vehicle requiring access to the Valve House or to carry out repairs to the dam structure; or
 - (e) a Class 3 invalid carriage.
- 6. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle from turning right (south-easterly) from the northern junction of the U7003 at Thirlmere (western road), onto the A591.
- 7. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle from making a U Turn on the A591 between a point approximately 85m north-northwest of Smaithwaite Bridge and a point approximately 363m east of its eastern junction with the U2922 Rough How Bridge road.
- 8. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
