 - i) Maryport Ewanrigg Road, Lawson Street (to replace "No Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30 am 6pm), A594 Ellenborough Road/Ashby Street, High Street, A596 and Gavel Street, Church Street (Park Terrace) & Christian Street (to replace "No Waiting Mon-Fri 8.30 am 9.30 am and 2.30 pm 4 pm");
 - ii) **Flimby** Cooperative Terrace, Farmers Way, Lowther Street, Ryehill Crescent, Ryehill Road and School Drive;
 - iii) Allonby Wigton Road;
 - (ii) "Disc Zone 2 Disc Parking places, waiting limited to 2 hours, return prohibited within 2 hours, resident permit holders exempt from the time limit, 8.30 am 6.00 pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive" on High Street and Crosby Street, **Maryport** (to replace "No Waiting At Any Time" restrictions);and
 - (iii) "Disc Zone 3 Disc Parking places, waiting limited to 2 hours, return prohibited within 2 hours, resident permit holders exempt from the time limit, 8.30 am 6.00 pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive" on Eaglesfield Street, Maryport (to replace a redundant police parking bay) and on High Street, Maryport.
