THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (WEST WALLS, CARLISLE) (PROHIBITION OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OVER 7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT) ORDER 2022

- 1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that on 5 July 2022 it made the above Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The Order will come into operation on 25 July 2022 and its effect will be to prohibit heavy commercial vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight from proceeding along the length of road detailed in the attached Schedule.
- 3. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks of 5 July 2022 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
