## THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (C2016 BROUGHTON BECK BRIDGE) (PROHIBITION OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OVER 13 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT) ORDER 2003

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2003 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (C2016 Broughton Beck Bridge) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles Over 13 Tonnes Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight) Order 2003
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 13 tonnes, to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule attached to this Order.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
