

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, CARLISLE URBAN AND RURAL AREA) (CONSOLIDATION AND PROVISION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) ORDER 2024

1. Cumberland Council hereby give notice that on 19th March 2024 it made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The Order shall come into operation on 5 April 2024 and its effect will be to consolidate and amend the restrictions and provisions of The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2023, as follows: -

Devonshire Street, Carlisle

- (i) Removal of the bus lane;
- (ii) Changes to the extents of the “No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions;
- (iii) Removal of some “No Loading/Unloading At Any Time” restrictions;
- (iv) Removal of “No Loading/Unloading – 8.00 am - 9.30 am, 12 noon – 1.30 pm, 4.30 pm – 6.00 pm, Monday – Saturday inclusive (north side for its full length);
- (v) Removal of the “Loading Only – All Day, Every day” area on the north side;
- (vi) New “Loading Only Area – 5 am – Midnight, every day” on the south side;

(NB: New “No Stopping Except Taxis, Midday-5am” on the south side – to be progressed under a separate Taxi Rank Order).

Victoria Viaduct, Carlisle

- (i) Changes to the extents of the “No Waiting At Any time” restrictions;
- (ii) New “No Loading/Unloading At Any Time” restrictions.

Castle Street/The Greenmarket

New “Restricted Street” - No Waiting At Any Time, No Loading/Unloading between 12 noon and 7.00 pm and Loading/Unloading only between 7.00 pm and 12 noon the following day (all vehicles, including buses and coaches) - (Waiting for Loading/Unloading limited to 1 hour).

Peel Street/ Bower Street

An Extension of “Zone E Parking restrictions” following a Zone review.

Peel Steet:

New “Disc parking restrictions – Monday – Friday 8am – 8pm, Sat 8am – 6pm waiting limited to 1 hour, Zone E residents exempt”.

Cranbourne Road

New “No Waiting at Any Time” Restrictions at the junction on the north and south side of cul-de-sac adjacent to house numbers 9-29

Bower Street

- (i) Removal of some existing “Disc parking” restrictions on the east and west side;
- (ii) New “No Waiting at Any Time” restrictions on the east and west side;

Kendal Street – Changes to “Zone B Parking restrictions” following a Zone review.

New “No Waiting at Any Time” restrictions on the south side at a number of junction entrances.

Spring Gardens Lane – Changes to “Zone C Parking restrictions” relating to planning approval of “The Stack” development (Lowether Street Car Park).

- (i) Removal of “Disc parking between 8.30am -6pm Monday – Saturday inclusive” on the north side; and
- (ii) New “No Waiting at Any Time” restrictions along the north side.

Mallyclose Drive/Forest Hill/Hopes Hill Drive/Highwood Crescent, Carlisle

Introduction of a 7.5 Tonnes maximum gross weight restriction”

Button Ford Bridge, Butterburn

Introduction of a 7.5 Tonnes maximum gross vehicle weight Restriction

Sunnythwaite Bridge, Longtown

Introduction of an 18 Tonnes maximum gross vehicle weight Restriction

4. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made there under has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks of 19 March 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
