UK Parliament general election EasyRead guide 2024



On Thursday 4 July 2024, there will a UK Parliament General Election across the UK.



At these elections you will need to bring photo ID to be able to vote at a polling station.



Lots of photo ID will be ok, like passports, driving licences and cards with a PASS mark on them



The name on your ID should be the same name you used to register to vote.





If you don't have an accepted form of ID, you can apply for a free voter ID document known as a Voter Authority Certificate.

The deadline to apply for the Voter Authority Certificate is 26th June.



You must be registered to vote by 11:59pm on Tuesday 18 June 2024.





The deadline to apply to vote by proxy is 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024.
