

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 244030 IN THE PARISH OF MARYPORT)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) (NO.2) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Order made by Cumberland Council on 10 October 2023, which became operative on 13 October 2023, because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to a damaged footbridge and to allow subsequent repair works to be carried out (“the Works”), and which would otherwise expire on 13 April 2024
:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 13 April 2025.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 8.5 metre section of Public Footpath No. 244030 at Flimby in the Parish of Maryport, between Grid References: 301361 532966 and 301351 532976

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.
