

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 103016 IN THE PARISH OF BEAUMONT)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Order made by Cumberland Council on 23 January 2024, which became operative on 2 February 2024, because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the flooding of the footpath and to enable subsequent repair works to be carried out (“the Works”) and which would otherwise expire on 2 August 2024
:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 2 February 2025.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 140 metre section of Public Footpath No. 103016 at Knockupworth (under the A689) in the Parish of Beaumont, between Grid References: 337197 556974 and 337266 556856.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works have not been completed within the extension period, the Order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the appropriate Minister.
