

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY NO. 119010 IN THE PARISH OF IRTHINGTON)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS, HORSES AND CYCLISTS)
ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Order made by Cumberland Council on 11 July 2023, which became operative on 19 July 2023, because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to a damaged bridge and to allow subsequent repair works to be carried out (“the Works”) and which would otherwise expire on 19 January 2024
:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 11 January 2025.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians, horses and cyclists along an approx. 2000 metre section of Public Bridleway No.119010 at Laversdale Beck in the Parish of Irthington, between Grid References: 345885 561355 and 347439 562261.

A suitable alternative route for pedestrians is available via Public Footpath Nos. 132006 and 119011 and the roadside verge of the U1095. There is no suitable alternative route available for horses or cyclists.

If the works have not been completed within the extension period, the Order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the appropriate Minister.
