

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 120008 IN THE PARISH OF KINGMOOR)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the dangerous condition of the footpath and to enable subsequent repair works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 551 metre section of Public Footpath No. 120008 at Kingmoor Park in the Parish of Kingmoor between grid references: 338226 559936 and 337873 559714.

There is no suitable alternative route for pedestrians on public highways although the contractor on site will provide a suitable alternative route at times when works allow and is deemed safe to do so. This will be signed on site.

This follows emergency notices dated 18 December 2023 and 8 January 2024.

The Order will come into operation on 29 January 2024 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, it is anticipated that it will be required for 6 months.
