(BRIDLEWAY NOS 250026 AND 250028 IN THE PARISH OF SEATON)(TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS, HORSES AND CYCLISTS) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable resurfacing works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians, horses and cyclists from proceeding along the following lengths of bridleway:

1. An approx. 387 metre section of Public Bridleway No: 250026 in the Parish of Seaton between its junctions with Main Road and its junction with Public Bridleway No 250028; and
2. An approx. 69 metre section of Public Bridleway No: 250028 in the Parish of Seaton between its junction with Public Bridleway No: 250026 and Grid Reference: 301460 530410.

A suitable alternative route for pedestrians will be available via the unrestricted sections of Public Bridleways Nos: 250026 and 250028, Bridleway No: 250029 and the footways of Main Road.

A suitable alternative route for horses and cyclists will be available via the unrestricted sections of Public Bridleways Nos 250026 and 250028, Bridleway No 250029 and Main Road.

The Order will come into operation on 2 October 2023 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required for 2 weeks.
