

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY NO. 251030 IN THE PARISH OF SEBERGHAM)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS, HORSES AND CYCLISTS) ORDER
2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to a landslide and to enable repair works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians, horses and cycles along an approx. 1350 metre section of Public Bridleway No. 251030 in the Parish of Sebergham between Grid references: 335753 540687 and 334669 540202.

A suitable alternative route for pedestrians is available via Public Footpath No. 251006. There is no suitable alternative route available for horses or cyclists.

This follows an emergency notice dated 28 May 2024.

The Order will come into operation on 18 June 2024 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, it is anticipated that it be required for 6 months.
