

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NOS. 417015, 417018, 417019, 417020 AND
417021 IN THE PARISH OF MORESBY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable West Cumbria Rivers Trust to carry out river restoration works (“the Works”), Cumberland Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along the entire lengths of the following Public Footpaths at Walkmill in the Parish of Moresby:-

1. Footpath No. 417015 between grid references: 299767 519075 and 299773 519321 with spur from grid reference: 300538 518830 to 300606 518647;
2. Footpath No. 417018 between grid references: 300620 518651 and 300542 518839;
3. Footpath No. 417019 between grid references: 300615 518672 and 300427;
4. Footpath No. 417020 between grid references: 300710 518794 and 300544 518839;
and
5. Footpath No. 417021 between grid references: 300705 519077 and 300564 519017.

There are no suitable alternative routes available for pedestrians.

The Order will come into operation on 12 February 2024 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. It is anticipated that the Works will take 6 months.
