Commons Act 2006 - Section 19(2)(a) NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Robert Charleton Thornton and Ann Thornton (Trading As J.C. Thornton & Son)** ("the Applicants") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL68, Birkby Fell - Muncaster.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: Entry numbers 21 and 22 were registered as a result of application number 1422 of 24 February 2012 ('the 2012 Application) which sought to apportion the right formerly registered at entry 19. The Applicants claim that the apportionment calculation contained within the 2012 Application was incorrect and that Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority was bound to verify the application in order to ensure compliance with subsection 9(5) of the Commons Act 2006. The Applicants claim that the Commons Registration Authority made a mistake either by not doing so, or by doing so incorrectly, by approving the application and so concluding that the land to which the right registered at entry 22 is attached carried the right to graze 419 adult sheep and followers or 42 cows and followers or their equivalents and 4 horses.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting entry number 22 and creating a new entry, which will entitle the current holders of entry number 22 to graze 317 adult sheep and followers or 32 cows and followers or their equivalents and 3 horses and the right to cut bracken furze and to take sand gravel and peat on the whole of the land comprised in the register unit.

Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
