Application to correct the register – mistake made by the registration authority.

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: CA10/37

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee (“the Committee”) on the 11th July 2018, considered an application to correct an apparent mistake in the register made by the CRA concerning the registration of land at CL11 Brackenthwaite Fell, Crummock Water (herein after referred to as “the Application Land”).

Decision

The Committee resolved to refuse the application to correct the register, thereby keeping the Application Land registered as common land.

Reasons

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer (“the Officer”). The Officer’s report made a recommendation to the Committee to refuse the application on the grounds that there is no evidence to suggest that Cumbria County Council as the registration authority made a mistake upon registration of the common, as they faithfully registered what they were asked to register by the original applicant..

Outcome

The CRA has given effect to the determination by leaving the Application Land registered as common land.
