**Application to correct the register – mistake made by the registration authority.**

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: CA10/25**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee (“the Committee”) on the 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017, considered an application to correct a mistake in the register made by the CRA concerning the registration of land at Natland (herein after referred to as “the Application Land) as a village green.

**Decision**

The Committee resolved to accept the application to correct the register and add the Application Land to the register of town and village green unit no. VG2 Natland Village Green.

The CRA has given effect to the determination by registering the Application Land as a village green which entailed the addition of a register amendment entry confirming addition to registered area and the amendment of the register map showing the Application Land marked as registered.

**Reasons**

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer (“the Officer”). The Officer’s report made a recommendation to the Committee to accept the application on the grounds that there is sufficient evidence that Cumbria County Council as the registration authority made a mistake upon creation of the second edition of register map under the Commons Registration Act 1965. The Application Land was mistakenly excluded from the boundary of town and village green register unit no. VG2.
