Application to correct the register**

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: CA10/57**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee (“the Committee”) on the 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022, considered an application to correct a mistake in entry 11 of commons register unit CL41 Roundthwaite Common.

**Decision**

The Committee resolved to reject the application.

**Reasons**

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer (“the Officer”). The Officer’s report made a recommendation to the Committee to reject the application on the grounds that (1) there is insufficient evidence that a mistake was made in 1969 when the right at entry 11 was registered under the Commons Registration Act 1965, and (2) by reason of reliance reasonably placed on the register by several persons who purchased parts of Roundthwaite Farm in 2014, it would in all the circumstances be unfair to correct the register.

**Changes to the Register**

No changes are required. Entry 11 of register unit CL41 will remain unaltered.
