**Application to amend the register to record an historic event – historic
extinguishment of a right of common**

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: CA14/22

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee (“the Committee”) on the 24th January 2018, considered an application to record an historic extinguishment of a right of common, namely the right of Woodmere exercisable over the whole of the land comprised registered as CL155, Land either side of A591, south of Waterhead (“the Right”).

Decision

The Committee resolved to accept the application to amend the register by showing the Right registered as extinguished.

Reasons

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer (“the Officer”). The Officer’s report made a recommendation to the Committee to accept the application on the grounds that the application had been duly made and there is sufficient evidence to prove that the Right had been extinguished.

Outcome

The register for CL155, Land either side of A591, south of Waterhead has been amended to show the Right registered as extinguished.
