**Application to amend the register to record an historic event– historic severance of a right of common.**

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: CA14/34**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has considered an application submitted by David Jonathan Dixon and Sally Dixon (“the Applicants”) to amend the register to record an historic severance of a right of common concerning the right to graze 350 ewes with their unweaned lambs at entry 27 of register unit CL54 Hellgill Howe and entry 24 of register unit CL95 (“the Right”).

**Decision**


The CRA resolved to accept the application to amend the register by registering historic severance of the Right.
