Application to amend the register to record an historic event – historic transfer of a right of common in gross.

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: CA14/64

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has considered an application submitted by **John Alistair James Read** (“the Applicant”) to amend the register to record an historic transfer of a right of common in gross concerning the right to graze 6 stints (one stint equalling one beast or 2 ½ sheep between 1st May and 28th October: sheep only to be grazed between 8th November and 28th March) and the right in the soil to cut turf and such rights of piscary as may be appurtenant thereto, on CL70 Burgh Marsh (“the Right”).

Decision

The CRA resolved to accept the application to amend the register by registering the Right in the name of the Applicant.


Reasons
