

The Commons Act 2006 - Schedule 3 para 2(b) Application to amend the register to record an historic event

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Alan Bennett** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority under Schedule 3 paragraph 2(b) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to rights of common on CL1 Watermillock Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 18 stints (each stint carrying a cow or half a horse or a 1/3 of a mare and foal or 4 ewes and lambs or 6 geld sheep) on Watermillock Common, being 920 acres approximately and comprising the whole of the land in this register unit ("the Right") is currently registered as held in gross at Entry 4 of register unit CL1 in the name of Richard Windle. The Applicant claims that the Right was transferred to him by way of a Contract dated 21st March 1983. The Applicant seeks by this application to register the Right in his name.

If the application is granted, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting the current entry and creating a new entry to show the Applicant as the owner of the Right.

Representations:

- must quote the Application No. CA14/71
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and
- must be sent to: The Commons Registration Service, Lady Gillford's House, Petteril Bank Road, Carlisle, Cumbria, CA1 3AJ.

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at **5pm** on **5th September 2019**.
