NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT
Secondary Application - Apportionment

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Paul Ewbank Dixon** (“the Applicant”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land registers CL93 North and East Mallerstang Common and CL94 Western Mallerstang Common, south of Friths.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze (a) 100 ewes with their unweaned lambs and 40 hogs or 14 head of cattle or sheep and cattle together on the basis of 1 head of cattle to 10 sheep, (b) 1 horse with foals at foot and (c) 3 pigs, over the whole of the land comprised of register units CL93 and CL94 (“the Right”) is registered as attached to Ing Hill Farm, Mallerstang, Westmorland comprising O.S. plots numbered 125, 141, 142, 149, 150, 152, 152a, 154 and 155 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the parish of Mallerstang, Westmorland at entry 3 of register unit CL93 and entry 2 of register unit CL94.

The Applicant seeks by this application to show that the portion of the Right associated with the conveyances dated (pre) 5th April 1978, 20th July 1978, 20th January 1979, 28th March 1990 and 17th February 1994, and the transfer dated 19th January 2001 (“the Transfer Documents”), for which severance is claimed, amounts to 37.78 ewes and 15.11 hogs or 5.29 cattle, 0.38 horses and 1.13 pigs.

This secondary application can only be considered if the primary application (CA14/46) is granted. If granted the Commons Registration will give effect to the determination by creating new entries in the register (making reference to CL 93 entry 3 and CL94 entry 2) to show the proportion of the Right attached associated with the Transfer Documents as severed and held in gross.


Any person wishing to make representations:

- must state the grounds on which they are made and must be signed by the person making them;

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at **5pm on 25th April 2018**.
