

**Commons Act 2006 - Section 15(2)
Applications for the registration of a new town or village green**

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INQUIRY

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as Commons Registration Authority, has determined that a Public Inquiry should be held to consider applications **CA9/4** and **CA9/8** made by **Mr Ian McIntyre** ("the Applicant") under section 15(2) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.


Both applications relate to the same piece of land, known locally as 'The Celtic', located at the junction of Empress Drive and Mikasa Street, South Walney, Barrow-in-Furness, as shown outlined in red on the attached plan ("the Application Land"). Applications CA9/4 and CA9/8 were received on 30th January 2019 and 4th April 2022 respectively, and both aim to show that a significant number of the inhabitants of any locality, or of any neighbourhood within a locality, have indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land for a period of at least 20 years; and, they continued to do so at the time of application. Although the applications concern the same piece of land an independent decision will be reached on each.

An independent Inspector, Alan Evans of Counsel, appointed by the Council will open the Inquiry at The Grasmere Room, The Forum, 28 Duke Street, Barrow-in-Furness, LA14 1HH at 10 am on Monday 5th September 2022. The Inquiry is due to close on Thursday 8th September 2022.

Anyone can attend the inquiry. Anyone who wants to be heard on the subject matter of the applications, may, at the discretion of the Inspector, give evidence at the Inquiry, or arrange for someone to do so on their behalf.

Anyone who proposes to address the inquiry should submit a skeleton argument, together with copies of any authorities relied upon, to Cumbria County Council by 5pm on Monday 29th August 2022. The skeleton arguments should be sent to the Commons Registration Service by either post or email using the details provided below.

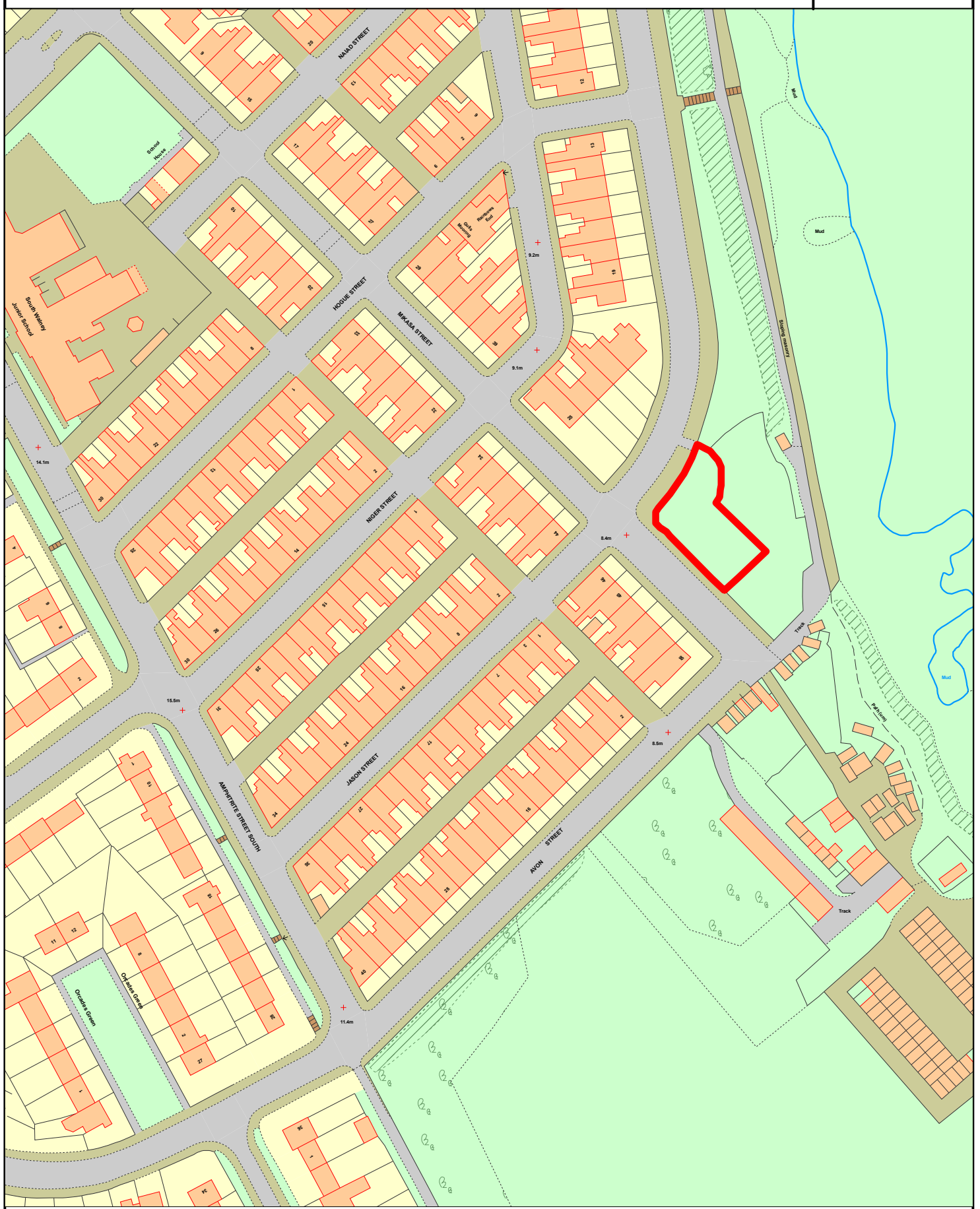
