

**A Proposal by Cumbria County Council  
Section 19 of the Commons Act 2006  
Correction of the Register  
Incorrect description of the land to which the right is attached**

In accordance with paragraph 18(1) of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 please find below a statement in writing describing the proposal and the justification behind it.

**Description of the proposal:**

It has become apparent that an error was made by the Applicants Arthur and Joseph Arthur Brownrigg when stating the 'Description of the farm, holding or other land to which the right is attached, if any' in Part 6 of the application number 908 dated 25<sup>th</sup> June 1968 and subsequently recorded at entry 12 of CL20 Caldbeck Common. O.S. Field number 956 was included twice in the original application and was included twice in the register by the Commons Registration Authority.

**Justification for the proposal:**

The Commons Registration Authority believe that correcting this mistake, and therefore ensuring the accuracy of the commons register would be in the public interest.

Notice is hereby given that a proposal has been made by **Cumbria County Council** ("the Proposer") as the Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(b) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The proposal relates to register unit CL20 Caldbeck Common

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: An application for the registration of a right of common was made on 25<sup>th</sup> June 1968 by Messrs Arthur and Joseph Arthur Brownrigg, Street Head, Hesket Newmarket, Wigton, Cumberland. The application stated that the right of common to graze 200 ewes and followers and 80 hogs should be attached to Street Head Farm, Hesket Newmarket, Part 967, Part 978, 933, 930, 929, 931, 939, 956, 935, 956, 957 and 979. On the application form, field 956 was included twice.

When the registration was made final on 7<sup>th</sup> October 1982, field number 956 was again included twice in the particulars of land to which the right was attached, reflecting the mistake on the application. The Proposer seeks by this proposal to correct that mistake.

If the proposal is granted the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entry 12 (making reference to the new corresponding entry) and making a new entry in the register with the duplicated field 956 removed.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the proposal and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and



To determine the proposal it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
