Before I go to the library

If I am nervous about going, I can talk to someone and ask questions first.

I can ask for a tour of the library when I get there.



About the library

There are people who work at the library who I can talk to.
All the library staff will wear a name badge showing their photograph and name.



The library is often a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax and read books.



Sometimes it might be noisy.
I can check before I go to see if any groups or class visits are expected.

When it is too noisy for me, I can request some ear defenders from a member of library staff.



How I become a member of the library

When I get to the library I will go to the Welcome Desk.
I will talk to someone who works there to become a member.



I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address (if I have one).



I will show them identification. This can be a driving licence, bank statement or household bill (dated within the last 3 months).

People under the age of 16 do not need to provide identification.



The library staff will put this onto their system then I will be a member of the library and given a library card and password.



When I visit the library

When I approach the library, the automatic doors will slide open.



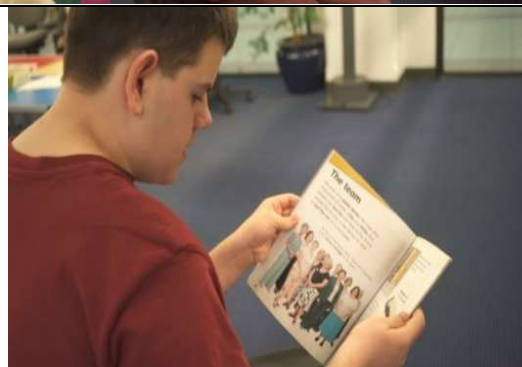
In the library there will be shelves of books and talking books.



I can sit in a chair and read.



I can borrow a book or talking book and take it home with me.



The staff will check out the book or talking book and stamp it to tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.



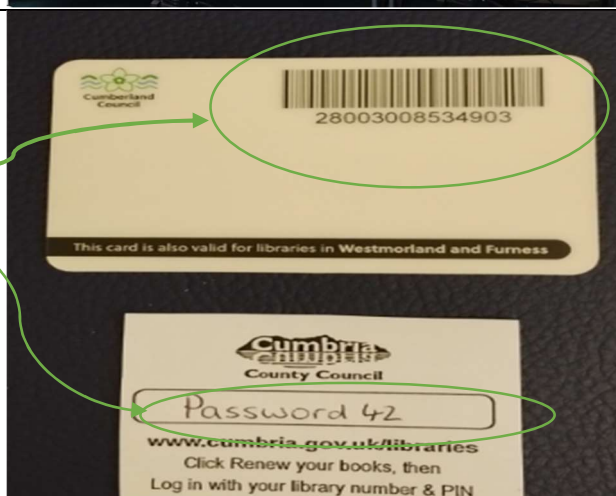
I can also ask to be shown how to use the self-issue machine to borrow and return my books or talking books.



The library has some computers and free Wi-Fi access.
The computers are free to use for up to 2 hours per day.



To log onto the computers, I will need to enter my Library card number and my password.



I will have to pay to print out:
20p per black and white copy
30p per colour copy.

When I am ready to print, I will go to a member of staff and ask for my print-outs and pay for them.



I can ask a member of staff to photocopy something for me. There is a charge to do this.

When I have finished, I will leave the library. As I approach the automatic doors, they will slide open.
