I'm going to Millom Library.

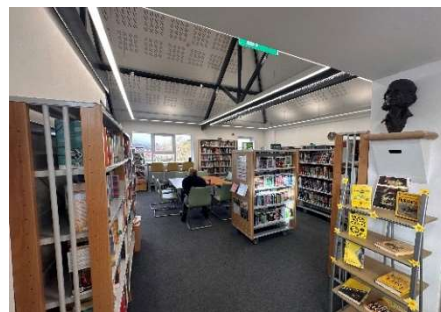


If I am nervous about going, I can talk to someone and ask questions first.

I can call 01229 777584.



I can ask the person for a tour of the library.



About the library

The entrance doors are automatic. The first set will slide across to open in front of me. The inside door has a button to press to my right that says “Touch to Open” and will open towards me.



There are people who work at the library who I can talk to.



All of the Library staff will wear a green name badge showing their photograph and name.



The library is often a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax and read books.



Sometimes it might be noisy. If it is noisy, I can talk to a member of staff.



When it is too noisy, I can request some ear defenders from a member of library staff.



How I become a member of the library

When I get to the library I will go to the Welcome Desk.

I will talk to someone who works there to become a member.

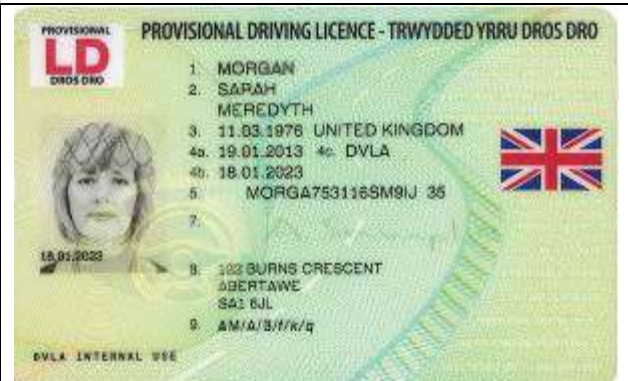


I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address (if I have one).



I will show them identification. This can be a driving licence, bank statement or household bill (dated within the last 3 months).

People under the age of 16 do not need to provide identification.



When I visit the library

In the library there will be shelves of books, and other resources.



I can sit in a chair to read a book



I can borrow a book, audio book, or resource bag and take it home with me.



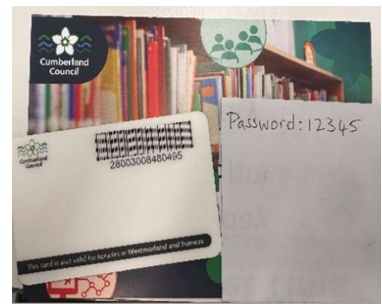
The staff will show me how to borrow the book or other item and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.



The library will also have some computers and free Wi-Fi access. The computers are free to use for up to 2 hours per day.



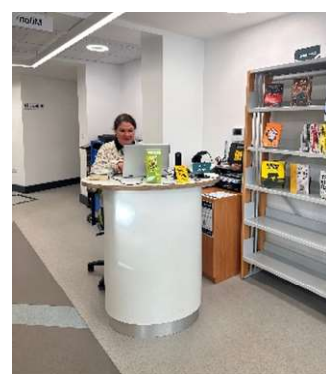
To log onto the computers, I will need to enter my Library card number and my password. This is the long number on the back of my library card and the password set up by staff.



I will have to pay to print out. 20p per black and white copy 30p per colour copy.



When I am ready to print, I will go to a member of staff and ask for my printouts and pay for them.



I can also ask a member of staff to photocopy something for me. There is a charge to do this.

The library offers regular Autism Sessions with extra resources including sensory equipment.



I can ask a member of staff to get out the Autism Resources and sensory items.

When I have finished, I will leave the library through the main door using the "touch to open" button to the left hand side of the door.
