## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 AND WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

## CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO 217001 PARISH OF BROMFIELD) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

On the 17 September 2024 Cumberland Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the whole width of that length of public footpath no 217001 at Blencogo Farm in the parish of Bromfield from Grid Reference 319678 548023 northeastwards and north-northwestwards for about 86 metres to Grid Reference 319655 548102; to run from Grid Reference 319678 548023 north-northwestwards for about 22 metres to Grid Reference 319688 548041 then east-northeastwards for about 22 metres across field to Grid Reference 319685 548055 then north-northwestwards for 56 metres to Grid Reference 319655 548102. The width of the section of path will vary between 2 and 3 metres.

The order comes into force on 27 September 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 27 September 2024 make an application to the High Court.
