

AMENDED NOTICE

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CARLISLE & DISTRICT) (CONSOLIDATION AND PROVISION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

1. Cumberland Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the proposed Order will be to consolidate the provisions of The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle City & District) (Consolidation and Provision of Speed Limits) (No. 9) Order 2023 and the following proposals, into one concise Order: -
 - i) The introduction of a 40 mph speed limit on the C1016 Cargo, from its junction with the A689 at Kingmoor Road West Roundabout, extending in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 560m; and
 - ii) The introduction of a 50 mph speed limit on the C1016 Cargo, from a point 560m north-west of its junction with the A689 Kingmoor Road West Roundabout, extending in a north-westerly direction to a point approximately 1.76km north-west of its junction with the A689 at Kingmoor Road West Roundabout, a total distance of approximately 1.2km.
