## AMENDED NOTICE

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CARLISLE & DISTRICT) (CONSOLIDATION AND PROVISION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20><

- 1. Cumberland Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order will be to consolidate the provisions of The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle City & District) (Consolidation and Provision of Speed Limits) (No. 9) Order 2023 and the following proposals, into one concise Order:
  - i) The introduction of a 40 mph speed limit on the C1016 Cargo, from its junction with the A689 at Kingmoor Road West Roundabout, extending in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 560m; and
  - ii) The introduction of a 50 mph speed limit on the C1016 Cargo, from a point 560m north-west of its junction with the A689 Kingmoor Road West Roundabout, extending in a north-westerly direction to a point approximately 1.76km north-west of its junction with the A689 at Kingmoor Road West Roundabout, a total distance of approximately 1.2km.
