CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FIRESHOW) ORDER 2024 SATURDAY 02 NOVEMBER 2024

ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ETC

NOTICE is hereby given that whereas during certain hours on Saturday 02 November 2024 certain highways in Carlisle will be thronged and liable to obstruction for the purpose of observance by the public of a large scale annual firework display and show Cumberland Council pursuant to powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said highways the following regulations shall be observed:

- 1. The following highways or roads will be closed to vehicular traffic between 00.01 hours and 23.59 hours on Saturday 02 November 2024 (the Date) as follows:
- (a) That highway or road or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) known as Dacre Road commencing from its junction with Devonshire Walk to its junction with Weavers Bank and the car park abutting the slip road leading from Castle Way shown coloured pink on the plan attached hereto ("the Plan") will be closed to vehicular traffic between 00.01 hours and 23.59 hours;
- (b) That highway or roads or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) known as Devonshire Walk from its junction with Mayors Drive to its junction with Castle Way shown coloured pink on the Plan will be closed to vehicular traffic between 00.01 hours and 23.59 hours;
- (c) That highway or roads or length of highway or road (adopted as maintainable at the public expense) know as Mayors Drive from its junction with Dacre Road and Devonshire Walk as far as the Sheepmount Athletics Stadium shown coloured pink on the Plan will be closed to vehicular traffic between 00.01 hours and 23.59 hours:
- (d) The suspension of the West Tower Street "Loading Only Bays" (Monday to Saturday, 8.00am to 6.00pm) from a point 12m from its junction with Market Street for 41m in a westerly direction between 00.01 hours and 23.59 hours on Saturday 02 November 2024.
- (e) That highway or road or length of highway or road and including the East-bound carriageway (adopted as maintainable at public expense) being a section of the A595 and forming in part and being known as Bridge Street and Castle Way commencing from its junction with Caldewgate to its junction with Devonshire Walk shown as black hatched area coloured blue on the Plan will be subject to a temporary single lane closure from approximately18:00 hours to 22.30 hours;
- (f) That highway or road or length of highway or road and including both the West-bound and East-bound carriageways (adopted as maintainable at public expense) being a section of the A595 and forming in part and being known as Bridge Street and Castle Way commencing from its junction with Caldewgate to its junction with Hardwick Circus Roundabout shown coloured blue on the Plan will be temporarily closed for 60 minutes from approximately 19.30 hours to 20.30 hours;
- (g) That highway or road or length of highway or road and including any slip road (adopted as maintainable at public expense) being a section of West Tower Street from the junction of Market Street to the junction and slip road of Castle Way both West bound and East bound shown coloured blue on the Plan will be temporarily closed for 60 minutes from approximately 19.30 hours to 20.30 hours;


- 2. Between 00.01 hours and 23.59 hours on Saturday 02 November 2024 all pedestrian traffic will be temporarily restricted from proceeding along the following footpaths shown red on the Plan: Footpath numbers 109083 (160m South-East from Sheepmount Bridge towards Weavers Bank), 109077 (100m North-East from Sheepmount Bridge) and 109078 (60m North-West from Sheepmount Bridge to Willowholme Industrial Estate) and 10985 from the entrance to the City Walls adjacent to Devonshire Walk and parallel to the South most part of Castle Car Park (in a Northerly direction along the City Walls to the most North point of the City Walls parallel to the junction between Devonshire Walk and Dacre Road and then proceeding in a South Westerly direction along the City Walls to the junction with Dacre Road and the entrance to the Bitts Park Car Park) and footpath 10986 (from its junction with Devonshire Walk and Dacre Road to its junction with footpath 10985). and footpath 109081 from its junction with Devonshire Walk and Dacre Road running parallel to the River Caldew and Mayor's Drive as far as the Sheepmount Athletics Stadium.
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done under the direction of or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden nor shall prejudice any right on the part of the highway or other appropriate Authority to take proceedings for any infringement, incursion or obstruction of any footpath or highway under the Highways Act 1980 or any other applicable enactment or the common law.
- 4. All persons with a vehicle (or on foot in respect of Footpath numbers 109083, 109077, 109078, 10985and 10986) will accordingly have to take alternative routes as appropriate other than those specified in this Order between the times specified therein on the Date.

The Order and explanatory maps showing the extent of the closures and restrictions may be inspected at the Customer Contact Centre, Ground Floor, Civic Centre, Rickergate, Carlisle Ca3 8QG and at Cumbria House, 117 Botchergate, Carlisle CA1 1RD between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Fridays up to close of business on Friday 01 November 2024 or viewed on the Council's website.
