

## **CUMBERLAND COUNCIL WORKINGTON ARMED FORCES PARADE ORDER 2024**

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ETC

WHEREAS during certain hours on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2024 certain highways in the area of the Cumberland Authority will be thronged and liable to obstruction for the purpose of a Carnival. Cumberland Council pursuant to powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and all other enabling powers do hereby order and direct that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said highways the following regulations shall be observed:

- 1. That during the period from 10:45am to 12:15pm on 29<sup>th</sup> day June 2024 ("the Date") that the roads known as Finkle Street, Vulcans Lane, Oxford Street and Jane Street, Workington as indicated by the red line on the attached plan ("the Plan") shall be closed to all classes of vehicular traffic, except emergency vehicles.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done under the direction of or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer nor shall prejudice any right on the part of the highway or other appropriate Authority to take proceedings for any infringement, incursion or obstruction of any footpath or highway under the Highways Act 1980 or any other applicable enactment or the common law.
- All persons with a vehicle will accordingly have to take alternative routes as appropriate
  other than those specified in this Order between the times specified therein on the
  Date.
- 4. This Order will come into operation at **10:45am** on the Date and may be cited as the Cumberland Council Workington Armed Forces Parade Order 2024.
- 5. Any wilful breach of this Order by any person shall be an offence against the above Act and every person committing any such offence shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale being £1,000.
